It's official! The Covid-19 pandemic is over. Open Door, like most agencies, spent the last year trying to balance the continuing need for health precautions while also figuring out what the new norm of "after Covid" will look like. The government funds are mostly gone and we are back to the reality of meeting the demands for our services with much more limited resources.

Services continue, yet look and operate a bit differently. The Community Food Ministry and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program have transitioned from its drive thru food pick up to, once again, inviting people in for conversation on how we can further help. The Klothes Kloset is now fully open for anyone who needs clothing, bedding, and small household items. The Family Rapid Rehousing Program stopped doing "porch visits" and returned to having true home visits in assisting previously homeless families become stable for the long-term.

The Homeless Resource Center, day shelter for homeless, is up to full capacity. Partner agencies, who left during Covid, are now returning. A case management pilot project with CARES funding assisting the most vulnerable to obtain/maintain housing is now returning with funding from The United Way of the Plains.

In FY2021-2022, United Way of the Plains staff member Jaraya starting working with Open Door Homeless Resource Center, day shelter program on a weekly basis to help find housing for the homeless. Due to our pilot program and our community partners **we housed 87 homeless through the housing initiative project.**

“Lloyd” had been homeless off and on since 1976. When he came home from Vietnam he never checked with the VA for services because he just wanted to forget about the war. So, shortly after returning home he began living on the streets, which only increased his self-medication of alcohol and drug use. He remained in a vicious cycle of sobriety/non-sobriety, homelessness and short stays in housing. He would never look into veteran benefits due to the trauma he experienced as a result of the war. In June 2022, as I came into the Director position, I began having small conversations with him. For several weeks and even months our talks were short and limited to brief descriptions of our service, but I would always greet him and make sure he was okay. After about four months I asked him about letting me get the VA to talk to him; the very mention of it upset him and he left the facility. I asked him a few more times afterwards and eventually he wanted to talk to them because he said the bitter cold and rain one weekend “almost killed him.” I am proud to say that he was put in touch with the VA here in Wichita and due to his service he was able to get housed/medical and food vouchers. He stopped by recently and he looked really well, happy and gaining weight! He has been housed for a little over two months now and is doing great! He would give me words of encouragement after I dealt with extremely difficult clients. I know it’s strange to say but his support let me know I was forging a good path for Open Door.
