### COMMUNITY FOOD MINISTRY

Monday thru Friday

9 a.m. - 11:45 a.m. & 1 p.m. - 3:45 p.m.

This is the largest community-wide food-box program in the Wichita area, providing emergency food assistance for individuals and families in need once per month. Families qualify at 185% of the federal poverty level. Spanish translation is available along with referrals to programs within the community. Donations of food and money to purchase food are always welcome. **7,020 unduplicated families/17,113 individuals were served 28,610 food boxes in 2024.**

\*NEW – The Community Food Ministry now offers a Hygiene Pantry on the first Wednesday of the month, supplying basic hygiene items to individuals and families in need. Donations of shampoo, bar soap, laundry soap, etc., are greatly appreciated!

### COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM (316) 267-0511

Monday thru Friday

9 a.m. - 11:45 a.m. & 1 p.m. - 3:45 p.m.

This monthly food-box program for income-eligible people age 60 and older distributes food provided by the USDA through the State of Kansas to people in Sedgwick and 10 surrounding counties. Elders qualify at 130% of the federal poverty level. Senior Commodities Week is the third full week of the month. **1,824 unduplicated individuals were served in 11-county area, totaling 15,663 food boxes.**

### KLOTHES KLOSET

Monday-Wednesday-Friday

9 a.m. – 1:45 p.m.

This program provides free clothing for infants, children and adults. Small household items are also available. Individuals and families may shop once per month. **Gently used clothing and household donations are accepted Monday through Friday 8 a.m. - 3 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m. – noon. Served on average 1,242 families per month.**

### HOMELESS RESOURCE CENTER

Monday thru Friday

7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.

The day shelter for the homeless provides case management, a daily meal, access to showers, laundry facilities and mail service. Individuals, churches and organizations provide the noon meal. In addition, several partner agencies such as GraceMed Health Clinic, VA, Shelter Plus Care, Hunter Health Clinic, ICT Street Team, and SACK offer services. **1,320 unduplicated individuals were served in 2024 with a daily average of 124 people.**

### FAMILY RAPID RE-HOUSING (FRRH)

Monday thru Thursday

8 a.m. - 4 p.m.

This HUD-funded program provides rental assistance and supportive services to literally homeless families, defined as at least one adult with a dependent child. A case manager provides support to address each family's unique barriers to achieving housing. The program's goal is to empower families to quickly regain stability in permanent housing and increase the family's self-sufficiency. **32 families/124 individuals were served in 2024.**

Many volunteer opportunities are available with Open Door programs, such as sorting or packing food and hygiene bags or answering the telephones; sorting clothing and stocking shelves in the Klothes Kloset; or preparing meals for the homeless at the Day Center. Individuals, families, and groups wanting to volunteer or needing community-service hours are scheduled on a one-time basis, monthly, weekly, daily or whatever best fits in with their lives. **Contact our Volunteer Coordinator.**
