Highlights from the Fiscal Year

Fiscal Year 2023 thru 2024

As always, I would like to thank all our donors, volunteers, and staff for their investment and hard work, which made all our programs possible in 2024. It is a vast understatement to say it couldn't be done without you. Despite economic uncertainties for both the agency and those we serve, the following are just a few highlights of the work in 2024:

- Open Door's Community Food Ministry distributed over 27,000 food boxes. This marks a 20% increase over 2023 and a 30% growth since 2022.
- The Head-To-Toe Hygiene Pantry was transferred to Open Door after operating for over a decade through University Congregational Church. Since May 2024, we have experimented to determine the best day and method for distributing much-needed hygiene items. We have settled on a Head-To-Toe Pantry Day on the first Wed. of each month. We average almost 300 families on distribution day, many of which also pick up a box of food. We still need your donations of funds, hygiene, and food items to support this work!
- We continue to actively participate in discussions with City, County, nonprofit colleagues, and business stakeholders to find creative and long-lasting solutions to homeless issues in our community. We are still asking questions to determine our role in the development of the multi-agency center (now called Second Light), as well as in housing navigation, outreach, and other areas. Open Door believes everyone deserves a home and stability to thrive, not just survive.

Open Door Annual Turkey Drive Fundraiser 2024

We certainly would not have had a successful Turkey Drive without the help of our community partners, *Wichita School District USD 259*, *Kansas Food Bank*, *KNSS* and *Audacy*, *WaterWalk*, *Cargill*, and our sponsors *INTRUST Bank* and *UMB Bank*.

With our community partners, sponsors, and individuals in the Wichita community coming together, *YOU helped* collect **3,524** turkeys, **37,202 lbs of side items**, and over \$33,000 in cash contributions for our Community Food Program Holiday Distribution.

Thanks to you, our volunteers, and staff, Open Door was able to distribute Holiday Food Boxes to **3,530 households/10,705** individuals!

Open Door Provides Hygiene Items to Individuals & Families in Need

In Spring 2024, after more than a decade of operations, the Head-To-Toe Hygiene Pantry moved from University Congregational Church to Open Door. The Pantry, initially open two half-days each month, switched to a single full-day per month, and continued growth in distribution is expected.

According to a research project commissioned by Feeding America, the following data was compiled among low-income households regarding the use of hygiene products:

33% of families report bathing without soap when they can't afford to purchase body washes.

31% of families report reusing diapers.

74% of families who can't afford basic household necessities skip laundry or washing dishes. Of this number, 63% will wash only the children's clothes to put their child's needs first.

50% of families worry about meeting their children's hygiene needs.

73% of low-income households cut back on food expenses to pay for hygiene products.

Open Door's Hygiene Packs provide essential items, including toilet paper, laundry detergent, bar soap, shampoo, deodorant, and toothpaste, giving recipients fresh opportunities to care for themselves. Additionally, toothbrushes, feminine hygiene products, adult absorbent briefs, baby diapers, and wipes are often available by request, extending even greater support.

By providing our clients with access to these free basic hygiene items, we help ensure they can allocate their limited income to other essential necessities.
